The QCMH, as such, ought never be organized; but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve."

"We ought not be organized, huh? Some of this service-stuff looks pretty organized to me!"

In tradition nine, the term "organized" refers to a structure based in rules, seeking strict control. The QCMH avoids this type of organization because it doesn't work for us. We live by spiritual principles, not man-made rules. We practice spiritual equality; where everyone has a voice, and decisions are made through group conscience.

Our organization has to function, though. And gathering a group conscience for every decision is impractical. Bills have to be paid, our facility has to be maintained and events need to be planned. If we all had to weigh-in on each decision, nothing would get done. So, we authorize trusted servants to carry-out our tasks and organize their efforts into committees that are responsible to those they serve.

Instead of rules about how things must be done, we provide guidelines; reflecting the will of our group conscience. Guidelines are a way to share past experience with present servants. They provide a set of logical procedures that have been used to fulfil the responsibilities of our various committees.

QCMH boards and committees provide the service of structure to our organization and allow for group conscience expressions. Our servants carry out their tasks in cooperation with our guidelines. This gives them confidence to know they are doing the work that is wanted by those they serve.
